### ④. Invitation of Japanese Instructors

The WKO office receives numerous invitations for Japanese instructors every year. Standard procedure calls for the Official Invitation Letter to be sent to the WKO Office with the necessary information filled in. The invitation becomes official only when the letter arrives at the WKO Office. Please refrain from direct negotiations with Japanese instructors, for it will only lead to problems in the future. Finally, we would like for all to understand that an agreement based on direct negotiations will not be considered an official invitation.

### ⑤. Acceptance of Students from Overseas Branches

Every year, numerous students from overseas branches visit Japan for the purpose of training. When a student wishes to visit Japan for training, standard procedure calls for the Branch Chief or Contact (whom the student belongs to) to contact the WKO Office of the ideal time frame, dojo, and detailed information (name, dan/kyu, age, etc.) of the student. The WKO Office will confirm the content of the request with the Branch Chief/Contact of the dojo in Japan. In a case where an overseas student goes forth with his/her training in Japan without consulting the WKO Office, it would delay the response time of the WKO Office if an emergency happened to occur. To assure the safety of the students, we ask for everyone’s cooperation in this matter.

### ⑥. Centralization of communication between Overseas Branches

It is required that communication (related to events within the organization) between Overseas

## Minutes of WKO General Assembly

- ◆ Date : October 16, 2023 (Mon.)10:00~16:00
- ◆ Place : Tokyo Dome Hotel B1F "Cynthia"  
Attendees : 220 Branch chiefs and 14 Contacts, Yamashita, Ishida (Interpreters from Simul International, Inc.)
- Midori made an opening address. Koi was recommended as a Chairman of the meeting, and Luigi Polimeno and Ken Kato as signatories to the minutes. This selection was approved by the attendants.
- Before moving to discussions, the special sponsors of the 13WC made presentations on their products and services.
  - ① Mr. Anthony Diaz, CEO of ZENZA Capital PTE.
  - ② Mr. Makoto Nishihata, CEO of Go Go Curry Group Co., Ltd.
- 1. Confirmation of the number of votes and validity of the general assembly
  - Koi reported the number of votes and declared the formation of the General Assembly. Among 377 Branch Chiefs and Contacts (Branch Chief 335/Contact 42), the number of votes are 225 (including 115 Branch Chiefs / 110 Letter of attorney)
- 2. Exchange of opinions regarding the 13<sup>th</sup> World Karate Championship
  - Midori expressed his gratitude for the support from all related members representing the organizer, and the attendees responded with warm applause. As a result of the enhanced PR campaign (Publicity in trains, SNS, TV, printed media, radio, etc.) the championship recorded the full audience turnout. We will continue to reinforce media appearances. The spectators' manners have improved, and less booing was heard. It turned out effective that Romas went to give the warning to those who booed on site. Midori praised the great achievement of Valeri Dimitrov who won 2nd place as a competitor in parallel to his duties as a Branch Chief.
  - Koi explained the review points and contributors in the championship management and expressed his appreciation; the performances of the junior members, Drum Tao and Mr. Tsuyoshi Nagabuchi, the financial contribution from a Branch overseas (Zsuga), cooperation from the Anti-Doping Committee members, cooperation in the long late night rehearsal of Mr. Nagabuchi, the turnout of 10,000 spectators on the final day, the progress time management, the financial supports (total of 256 companies) gathered by the Japan region members led by Midori, and the cooperation of Kata referees who made core role in realizing the first Kata category.
  - Kobayashi thanked the cooperation from all the referee members as the Chairman of the Referee Committee and promised to improve the refereeing by reviewing the problems and studying the issues. As the Kata category was held for the first time, we focused on having

the same standard of judgment and sharing an aligned perception of the details in advance. We had a lot of participation of observers in the referee meeting held before the championship. It was effective that we proceeded to align the judging criteria, watching the video of Japanese and European Kata tournaments in the referee meeting. Asking the referee members to watch the Kata DVD beforehand and prepare for the meeting also led them to success. There were requests to continue the efforts to ensure standardization and fairness in Kata refereeing. Also, although there were understandable circumstances, each Kata competitor should perform individually, as it is very difficult to judge fairly when the two opponents perform simultaneously. In Kumite, there was an opinion concerning the foul play judgment (pushing) in the men's final. We asked for the understanding of the cautious judgment of the situation, as there was only one corner flag raised to point out the foul and it was not a majority decision. If the main referee gathered the corner referees to give the caution to be aware of the fouls, it may have affected and biased their judgments.

→In conclusion, we must be respectful and grateful to the referees of the championship, understanding their great responsibility and efforts. Also, it requires the raised awareness that the result of the judgment may affect the course of competitors' lives. So, we need to continue our efforts to improve our refereeing quality to avoid any misjudgments. If there are any individual requests to review a specific bout, it is requested to send it to the WKO Referee Committee.

3. Report of matters approved and proposed at the Board Meeting

- Koi gave the overall explanation of the discussions and the approved matters in the board meeting and requested to refer to the details in the Minutes which will be sent out shortly.

4. Report of final accounts for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 and Auditor Report, as well as the budget plan for Fiscal Year 2023-2024

- Koi reported the final accounts and called for questions. The Auditors followed by submitting the auditor report.

◆ Approved : Final accounts for Fiscal Year 2021-2022, and the budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024, as well as the additional budget for 2023 which has been approved in the board meeting.

5. Reports from each committee

- ① Technical Committee Fujihara reported the overall management of the World Karate Seminar. We came to hold the seminar in Haneda due to unavoidable circumstances, but it resulted in an increase in convenience with less transportation. As to the teaching aspect, we appointed the world champions (Tsukamoto, Tsukagoshi, and Shimamoto) as instructors, having participants enjoy the exchanges as well as the training.

- ② Grading Committee                      Midori reported the result of the recommended Dan promotion. The detailed information is to be referred to in the Newsletter which will be distributed at the end of October.
- ③ Referee Committee                      Kobayashi mentioned that taking the previously expressed opinions sincerely, he would make utmost efforts to improve the refereeing.
- ④ Anti-Doping Committee                  Naito reported the number of test samples collected in the World Championship. It was 8 samples at the last championship, but we increased the number of test samples to 12 (2 for Kata and 10 for Kumite) to enhance the anti-doping activities.
6. Grant discharge, and dissolution of the WKO Board, introduction of new Board Members from each region
- The attendants approved to exempt the responsibility of the Board Members for their term, and granted discharge to the Board.
  - Midori made an end of term speech, and the attendants gave the Board Members a warm applause, as a sign of gratitude for their hard work during their term. The Auditors also finished their term and were given warm applause for their efforts.

  - The General Assembly took a short break while the Extraordinary Board Meeting was held by the new Board Members.
  - As a result of the Extraordinary Board Meeting, the following new positions were announced.

    - Secretary General          Kazuo Miyoshi

- In addition, it was reported that the discussion over the selection of the Committee Members has been made. The subject will be discussed further at the next Board Meeting.

7. Found of the WFKO and the holding of the 1<sup>st</sup> World Fullcontact Championship
- Midori reported the co-creation with Osaka EXPO and the status of the preparation. Sakamoto added that he works together closely with the executive members of EXPO. It is also announced that the 8th World Championship in Weight Categories is prepared to be held simultaneously. Although the organizing body is the WFKO, with the necessity of conducting the anti-doping test, the WKO, who is a WADA code trustee, will be the co-organizer. It was reconfirmed that the WFKO championship will have 5 categories in both men's and women's divisions, which will have 16 competitor slots in men's each category and 8 competitor slots in women's each category. There was a request to increase the slots in the women's category, which will be examined by the executive committee. However, it was also pointed out that we already have more categories compared to the 7WC in Poland.
  - The question related to the preliminary tournaments was raised from the Europe region. Spitaels, who has been organizing the European Fullcontact Karate Camps for 4 times since 2016 and the 1st EFKO Fullcontact Karate Championship (January 2020, in Antwerp, Belgium), requested to clarify the roles and positions of EKO and WFKO on the management and organization of the preliminary tournaments.  
→We understand that the European region is composed of many countries and in a multi-language environment, different from the situations in Japan or Russia, which makes it difficult to organize Fullcontact activities. Our response concerning EFKO (WFKO European board members) was that we would like the EKO to play the leading part in harmonizing with other Fullcontact Karate groups, same as JKO fulfills the managerial role in the JFKO structure. Also, related to the Japan region's Fullcontact Karate activities, the comparison in WKO's open policy (promotes positive exchanges with other groups) and Matsui group's closed policy which they have been maintaining for a long time (limits the exchanges within their group and few selected groups such as Seido Kaikan) was mentioned. The latter shows the evident trend of downsizing. If we compare the number of Japanese competitors in this year's All Japan Karate Championships, there is a significant difference: we had 380 Japanese participants (JFKO All Japan Championship), while they only had 100 (Kyokushin Matsui Group's All Japan Championship). As such, we requested the Europe region to enhance the cooperation between the different groups, within Regional Board Members and among Branch Chiefs, based on the understanding of the legitimacy of our strategy of uniting the different groups of the Fullcontact Karate movement.

8. Call for candidate application as a host country of the 9th World Karate Championship in Weight Categories (2029)

- Koi gave the overall explanation of the candidate's application. Hungary, Singapore, and Kazakhstan showed their interest in hosting the 9WC. We will announce further details and the conditions of the application to related countries.

9. Miscellaneous

Midori gave the overall explanation on the holding of the “Champion of Champions” (Sunday, 21 July 2024 at Yoyogi 2<sup>nd</sup> Gymnasium) He added that we want to create the dream stage for the Fullcontact Karatekas around the world and it is planned to be showcased, with prize money and using the professional stage production. The amounts of prize money will be 10,000,000JPY each for the men and women champion, 2,000,000JPY each for the men and women in 2nd place, 600,000JPY each for men and women in 3rd place (no 3<sup>rd</sup> place match), and 300,000JPY each for all the participants as a Participation Reward. We will select the participants and contact them through their Branch Chief to confirm their intention to compete.

## Minutes of WKO Board Meeting

- ◆ Date: October 12, 2023 (Thu.) 14:00-18:30
  - ◆ Place: Tokyo Dome Hotel 5F “Horai”
  - ◆ Attendants: Midori, Kobayashi, Scharrenberg, Miyoshi, Fujihara, Kimoto, Tsukamoto, Michel, Vitkauskas, Sujoto, Makki, Mashinini, Volke, Carvalho (WKO Board members)  
Koizumi, Harauchi, Cleveringa (WKO Auditors), Koi (WKO Executive Director)  
Yamashita, Ishida (Interpreters from Simul International, Inc.)
  - Midori declared the opening of the meeting at 14:00 and moved to the agenda. Volke and Fujihara were recommended as signatories to the minutes and have been approved.
1. Greetings from the 13th World Championship organizing country and report on operational aspects
    - (1) Midori expressed his appreciation to the board members who came to Japan. He explained that the total cost of the championship would exceed 300,000,000 JPY, part of which is the result of an increasing PR campaign to ensure audience turnout. He added the topic of the diamond sponsor (110,000,000 JPY), Zenza Capital Holdings Co., Ltd, introducing their company profile and that there will be a presentation at the General Assembly.
    - (2) Koi reported the measures taken to respond to the requests from the European region; disclosure of the setting method of the tournament draw and measures to ensure the fairness of selecting the special referee team members. To ensure the fairness of the tournament draw, the seed ranking was determined, based on the points attributed to the recent main tournament results. In addition, the setting of the Kumite and Kata tournament draws was made with the presence and collaboration of the European board members.
    - (3) Kobayashi explained that the referee skills and the fair distribution balance of regions were considered for the composition of the special referee team members, and priority was given to the fair distribution of regions.
  2. Continual restriction of the Russian region to participate in international championships
    - Miyoshi called for discussion on whether WKO will continue the restriction of their participation in international championships, following the recommendation made by the International Olympic Committee (IOC) to the International Sports Federation (IF) to allow Russian and Belarusian athletes to take part in international competitions as neutrals in this March, as well as the decision made by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) in this September to allow the Russian and Belarussian athletes to compete as neutrals.
    - As a result of the discussion, most of the European board members shared the opinion that they sympathize with the Russian Karatekas' feelings, but have no choice but to continue the restriction as long as the war situation continues.
    - ◆ Approved : Restriction will continue for an undetermined time. The revision of the decision will be made according to the situation change.
  3. Exchange with other international organizations
    - Tsukamoto called for discussion concerning the restriction of participation in the competitions such as “SENSHI”, organized by Kyokushin World Union (KWU), kickboxing, MMA, etc. KWU is an International Sports Federation, mainly based in Russia, with whom WKO made a partnership in 2015 to promote “Kyokushin” globally. However, taking the current situation of the Ukraine crisis which started in 2022 into consideration, KWU has moved its center of organization to Bulgaria. Recently, KWU has been hiring famous figures such as Japanese instructors Masuda and Narushima, or the world champion who

left the Matsui group (such as Francisco Filho) with recompense. Given these circumstances, we come to the time to reconsider the relationship with KWU. Especially, the KWU Summer Camp coincides with the camp of the WKO Bulgaria Branch. In this regard, we emphasized the necessity that WKO-affiliated branches prioritize adding value to the WKO (Bulgaria) than to KWU activities.

→ As a result of the discussion, being vigilant to KWU's solicitation backed by their rich financial resources, WKO enhances its self-help efforts such as enhancing its PR campaign and promoting new events. (ex. Champion of Champions) We've come to a consensus that we would make WKO more attractive to young athletes by implementing new measures.

Basically, participation in professional Martial Arts competitions is not allowed. We reconfirmed our current policy that if a member wishes to participate in such competitions, he/she must withdraw from WKO's membership. That being said, depending on the applicant's intention or country-specific circumstances (inevitable participation), there may not be a choice but to make a decision. For example, the participation of Kazakhstan fighters in the KWU event (Student Championship in 2023) was such a case. WKO cannot give the permission but understanding that it is unavoidable circumstances, left the decision to the country and required the report to the concerned country's WKO branch and provide them an explanation of the background. WKO is open to promoting competition-level exchange between other groups. Especially in JFKO and WFKO championships, this policy is reflected in the number of participants. (We had 380 participants in the JFKO All Japan Championship in 2023.) On the contrary, Kyokushin Matsui Group has had a closed policy for a long time, and they had approximately 140 participants in their All Japan Championship In Weight Categories in 2023, and 40 of them were foreign fighters including Russians.

4. Report of final accounts for Fiscal Year 2021 & 2022 & Auditor Report, as well as the budget plan for Fiscal Year 2023&2024
  - Koi reported the Financial Results and called for the questions. The auditors submitted the auditor's report.
    - ◆ Approved : Final accounts for Fiscal Year 2021 & 2022, and the budget for Fiscal Year 2023&2024
  - Japan region proposed four additional budgets from the fiscal year 2023 as follows.
    - (1) Increasing the outsourcing fee for JKO
      - We had a large increase in the numbers of the affiliated country and branch chief compared to 2010. Also, due to the increase in international championships, international exchanges (camps and seminars), WADA related tasks, we require one more staff. (3 → 4 persons)  
A request for an additional budget of 300,000 JPY/month (3,600,000 JPY/year)
    - (2) Reviewing the organizer's cost coverage for further World Championships
      - As the number of branch chiefs increases, the hotel coverage cost increases accordingly. The organizer covered the hotel cost for all the branch chiefs who met the requirements until now, but we would like to propose limiting the coverage to 1 person per country from the next world championship (including the World Championship in Weight Categories) To be precise, the accommodation coverage for WKO board members, Auditors, Headquarters staff, Committee members and referees will remain the same.

- (3) Increasing financial support to World Championships  
 → The worldwide energy price hike and exchange rate (weak Japanese yen) significantly impacted the increase of expenses for the 13th World Championship. Not only did the airfare and hotel costs for overseas fighters skyrocketed dramatically, but the hotel costs for branch chiefs increased as the number of branch chiefs increased.

A request to increase the previous amount of 10,000,000JPY to 15,000,000JPY in total.

- (4) International roundtrip airfare coverage by WKO for the officials  
 → WKO's income is increasing as the number of affiliated countries and branch chiefs increases. As such, WKO covers the international travel costs for the board members, auditors, and committee members, who have their duties in the world championships. (including the World Championship in Weight Categories)  
 However, the conditions are set separately (such as flight class and the upper limit, etc.) and it applies from this championship.

◆ Approved : The adoption of all proposals above. (1~4)

## 5. Reports from each committee

- (1) Technical Committee Fujihara reported on the outline of the World Karate Seminar (October 17 &18) and the assignment of instructors.
- (2) Grading Committee Midori reported the discussion of the recommended Dan promotion (101 applicants in total) including the approval of 96 members and disapproval of 5 members by the Grading Committee. (3 members to 8th Dan, 1 member to 7th Dan, and 1 member to 5th Dan)
- (3) Referee Committee The movements of the main referee in the Kata competition were explained. (during the bout and the moment of decision)
- (4) Anti-Doping Committee The number of test samples to be collected in this championship was confirmed.

→ The WKO board supported the decision of the Grading Committee on the approved cases. On the other hand, the board members reviewed the four out of five disapproved applicants. (3 members to 8 Dan and 1 member to 7 Dan) These candidates are approved for their remarkable contribution as board members, and that surpassed the expectations even making up for the shortage of the length of experience required in Grading Regulations. As a result, the WKO board requested the Grading Committee to reconsider the cases and agreed to leave the decision to their discretion.

→ Two Kata athletes on the 1st day and eight athletes on the final day (Best 4 in men's and women's category, and 2 athletes from best 5 to 8 in men's category, i.e., the defeated competitors in the 1st and 4th match of the quarterfinals.) In addition, the implementation of the anti-doping test is requested in other regions than Europe and Japan, which is important for WKO to maintain WADA code compliance. We asked for the understanding that we may risk losing our qualification unless we don't comply worldwide. WKO Headquarters is looking forward to the further involvement of the Asian region, especially the collaboration from Shihan Patrick who is positively tackling the matter.

## 6. The 1st World Fullcontact Karate Championship (May 2025) and the related issues

- (1) Preliminary tournaments in each region, the number of competitors from each region, and the progress status of the co-creation with Osaka EXPO were reported.
- (2) Simultaneous holding of the 8th World Championship in Weight Categories, and the co-hosting by WFKO and WKO to implement the WADA code were reported.
- (3) The Japan region proposed to increase the weight division in the men and women category from the 8th World Championship in Weight Categories in 2025.

The proposal from Japan Region      Women -50kg/-54kg/-59kg/-65kg/+65kg



- ◆ Approved : The proposal from Japan was approved.  
The change in the men category has already been approved at the General Assembly in 2019. [Men category will be divided into 5 categories from 2025. (-60kg /-70kg /-80kg /-90kg /+90kg) ]

7. Information from the WKO Headquarters

(1) Holding of the “Champion of Champions”

“Champion of Champions” will take place on Sunday, 21 July 2024 at Yoyogi 2<sup>nd</sup> Gymnasium, simultaneously with the Karate Dream Festival International Championship 2024 (at Tokyo Metropolitan Gymnasium). We want to create a dream stage for the Fullcontact Karatekas around the world. It is planned to be showcased, using professional stage production. The participants (8 men and 8 women competitors) will be selected by the organizing committee after the 13th World Championship. The total prize money will be 31,200,000JPY (10,000,000JPY each for man and woman champion, 2,000,000JPY each for man and woman 2nd place, 600,000JPY each for man and woman 3rd place, and 300,000JPY each for all the participants).

(2) Miscellaneous: International Regulations and GAISF-related matters are in process, gathering information. We called for understanding that WKO Headquarters is undertaking various important matters according to priority.



## Minutes of the WKO Grading Committee Meeting

- **Recommendation of the 3 members from Japan (Kobayashi, Fujihara, Miyoshi) short in 17days for their promotion**

A request for approval from the Japanese Region due to their contribution being remarkable, and the promotion being a high rank, despite the shortage of 17 days.

→Shihan Fitkin mentioned that it would be unfair for those who could not be recommended due to the shortage of a few days. He also asked for the reason to rush the promotion.

→Shihan Bulow proposed to set the qualification date to the end of June in the year of the World Cup, and the end of October in the year of the World Championship. This proposal was suggested for the date of the Grading Committee Meeting differing each year.

⇒This proposal is to be considered in future meetings.

➔The proposal of the 3 members was put on hold

The Headquarters provided information on the unsolved financial trouble.

## Minutes of the Anti-Doping Committee meeting

### 1. Discussion on the number of doping inspections.

In previous World Championships, 8 were selected at the last 12th World Championship. Only from Kumite (Men: 1st to 4th, Women: 1st to 4th)

There was a strong request from the European side to increase the number of inspections, so the number was increased by two, bringing the total to ten.

As there will be a new kata competition, two samples will be selected from the kata competition, making a total of 12 samples.

2 from Kata competition (1st winner of men and women), 10 from Kumite competition (Men: Selected from the 1st to 4th placed competitors. 2 samples randomly selected from 5th to 8th placed competitors. Women: Selected from the 1st to 4th placed competitors.)

### 2. Discussion on how to select the randoms.

Discussions were held on how to randomly select from 5th to 8th competitors.

In previous World Championships, they have been randomly selected after all the matches have been played and the rankings have been determined.

It was suggested that it is better to decide in advance, as it is too late to wait until all the matches are over.

After discussion, it was noted that selection from Blocks A and D would be the same as the selections once the best eight had been decided.

Due to the time required for the inspection, it was decided to select from the losers of Blocks A and B.

### 3. Schedule for Doping Inspection

At previous World Championships, the inspections took place after the end of the second day of competition.

Due to the addition of kata competitions, there will be an inspection on the

Saturday 14th and Sunday 15th.

The time is scheduled for 12:00-13:00 after the Kata competition on Saturday 14th and around 17:00 after the Kumite competition on Sunday 15th.

#### 4. Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE)

Three competitors from Denmark, Poland and Canada applied for a TUE in this Competition.

The applications have been reviewed and approved by the TUE Committee.

The result will be recorded in the ADAMS database operated by WADA.

#### 5. Doping control at other regional competitions.

Currently, doping controls are only carried out at competitions in Japan and the European Region. It should also be carried out in other regions.

There are some opinions that even if there is a desire to conduct doping tests, there are differences in the cost of testing in different countries. In some countries it can be very expensive and make it difficult to conduct.

#### 6. Nomination of new Committee members.

Mr. Patrick Teo recommended Ms. Alice Nakamura as a new member of Anti-Doping Committee. There was not enough time to discuss the matter.
