Cadets, born in 2008 - 2009

Kumite girls: -50, -55, -60, -65, +65 kg

White shin protection with instep with full foot protection, groin protection, knee protections and white gloves are compulsory. Girls must also wear white breast (Cups) protectors. Girl competitors may wear a white T-shirt under their dogi. A compulsory EKO unified helmet to protect the chin, the face with a net/bars or plastics, top and back of the head, to be provided by the hosts. A compulsory EKO protective vest to protect the front and back of body and shoulders as well to be provided by hosts. Teeth protectors are optional but recommended.

Kumite boys: -50, -55, -60, -65, -70, -75, +75 kg

White shin protection with instep with full foot protection, groin protection, knee protections and white gloves are compulsory. A compulsory EKO unified helmet to protect the chin, the face with a net/bars or plastics, top and back of the head, to be provided by the hosts. A compulsory EKO protective vest to protect the front and back of body and shoulders as well to be provided by hosts. Teeth protectors are optional but recommended.

Techniques allowed for the Jodan zone: Mawashi Geri, Uchi Mawashi Geri, Kake Geri.

The techniques are to be performed with controlled force by touching the helmet. Any technique carried or performed with uncontrolled force is not permitted.

Techniques for the Gedan zone are prohibited.

It is the competitor's obligation to show up for the fight within the regulation time of 1 minute wearing a complete set of protective gear.

The kata cannot be repeated in subsequent rounds

Youth, born in 2004 - 2006

Kumite women: -50, -55, -60, -65, +65 kg

White Shin with instep protection covering the full foot, knee and groin protection are compulsory. A compulsory EKO unified helmet to protect the chin, most of the face, top and back of the head, helmets to be provided by hosts. Teeth protectors are optional but recommended. Women must also wear white breast (Cups) protectors. Women competitors may wear a white T-shirt under their dogi.

Kumite men: -65, -70, -75, -80, -85, -90, +90 kg

White Shin with instep protection covering the full foot, knee and groin protection are compulsory. A compulsory EKO unified helmet to protect the chin, the face with a net/bars or plastics, top and back of the head, to be provided by the hosts. Teeth protectors are optional but recommended. It is the competitor's obligation to show up for the fight within the regulation time of 1 minute wearing a complete set of protective gear.

Next turns: Sushiho, Kanku Dai, Seienchin, Seipai, Garyu

The kata cannot be repeated in subsequent rounds

Open Adults:

Minimum age for competitors must be 18 years on day of competition.

Men should have a groin protector (suspensor), jaw protector optional.

Women should have a groin protector (suspensor), cup-shaped breast protector and white soft cotton shin-foot protectors, with a jaw protector optional.

It is the competitor's obligation to show up for the fight within the regulation time of ONE minute wearing a complete set of protective gear.

There will be no Tameshiwari competition.

Requirements:

At the registration and medical control, all participants are requested to present:

- Medical certificate (English), not older than 1 month
- Minors must have their parents' consent by English to take part in kumite competitions
- Proof age (ID or passport)
- EKO passport with 2024 stamp
- All protectors and Karate-gi according to the rules.
- Competitors are obligated to bring their personal set of protectors (except helmets and chest protection) and must submit for approval at registration. Equipment shop with approved protection will be available at the venue on both competition days.

The organizer provides helmets and torso protectors (hogo).

Categories and number of participants:

- > 2 participants per country in each weight category KUMITE andind ividual KATA
- 2 team per country in each category of mix TEAM KATA
- Organizing country has one extra participant / Team in each category
- Cadets, Youth and Adults OPEN weight tournament 1st, 2nd, 3rd places will be awarded with medals / certificates
- Special EKO Competition award for Cadets, Youth and Adult Open weigh category
- ► Medal Winners (1st 3rd places) at ADULTS EC/WC in weight category or Open Weight EC/WC (1st 8th place) cannot register for Youth

Strongly recommended:

The tournament organizers recommend having your own accident insurance, with the option of practicing martial arts.
