### 1. Message from the WKO President

Dear WKO Branch Chiefs and Contacts,

Every day, I feel that the WKO is making a great progress, thanks to your support.

April 26 was the Death anniversary of Sosai Masutatsu Oyama, the founder of the Kyokushin Karate.

That day when I received the news of his sudden death, although I could not believe it was true, I hurried over to Sosai who was resting peacefully in his coffin. It was a loss and sadness that cannot be put into words. I still remember the weight I felt in my palms, when I put my hand on the coffin in which Sosai rests, being transferred from Sohonbu Dojo into the hearse car.

It has already been 30 years since the sorrow. In the spring sunshine and fresh breeze, I visited the Gokokuji Temple in Tokyo's Bunkyo Ward where Sosai rests in peace. I cleaned his grave, poured water over it, and laid colorful flowers. With the scent of incense and the feeling of the weight of the coffin on that day in my palms, I silently joined my hands, closed my eyes and spoke to him, "Thank you, Sosai Oyama, I will continue to be hand in hand with branch chiefs around the world to carry your legacy. "

Shihan Masahiko Yamada of the Nagasaki branch suddenly passed away in March, and then Shihan Miranda Hoyos of the Bolivia branch in South America suddenly departed as well to Sosai Oyama. I imagined as I left the Gokokuji Temple of them sweating to train Kihon in heaven.

In the WKO, a number of big tournaments are in full swing.

The regional selection tournaments for the 1<sup>st</sup> WFKO Championship scheduled for May 31 and June 1, 2025, in Ariake, Tokyo are active worldwide.

In Japan, the National Competitors were selected at the 9<sup>th</sup> JFKO Championship in Osaka (May 25 & 26). It was an extremely high-level tournament where 375 fighters from 364 different groups and organizations competed.

It has been reported that the All-European Championship, which served as the 1<sup>st</sup> selection tournament, was also held on the same day in Spain (Country Representative – Shihan Pedro

Soriano). The All-European Championship is a prestigious event with a long tradition. After the retirement of Mr. Valeri Dimitrov, who has been at the top of Europe for more than two decades and won 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the last World Championship, we could sense the budding of the new era with the rising of the young generation and the remarkable performances of the Georgian fighters. I was also happy to hear that Mr. Eventas Guzauskas, who had a bitter defeat in the World Championship, won the heavyweight category. Feeling the difficulty to keep winning, and learning from the retirement of the great warrior, Mr. Valeri Dimitrov. I believe it was a win overcoming many walls. I am looking forward to seeing his fights on the world stage.

The 1<sup>st</sup> WFKO Championship mentioned earlier, is our flagship tournament promoting our Karate style to be recognized as an Olympic Sport and will simultaneously serve as the WKO's 8<sup>th</sup> World Championship in Weight Categories. It is originally our championship, but it shows our determination to fully serve and devote ourselves to leading toward the achievement of the greater goal of uniting the Fullcontact Karate world.

During the selection tournaments booming worldwide, I hope that the staff and competitors are conscious of this greater goal and that as many WKO fighters as possible will participate in selection tournaments.

Secondly, the Karate Dream Festival 2024 International Championships will take place on July 20 & 21 at Tokyo Metropolitan Gymnasium. It has been 6 years since the last international Karate Dream Festival was held in 2018. The application period has been closed and we received more than 3600 applications. The scale of this event may be the largest in the Fullcontact Karate world. With the Karate Champion of Champions being held simultaneously on July 21, the presence of the WKO will surely attract global attention.

For those who will participate in the events, please prepare yourselves by training as much as possible not leaving any regret to facing your bouts in the mother country of Karate. I am looking forward to seeing you all at the venue.

Lastly, the time of patience has been lasting worldwide due to the international conflicts symbolized by the crisis in Ukraine. The damage and fear borne by the Ukrainian people is beyond measure. At the same time, I understand that the Russian Karatekas have been persevering. We pray for the earliest recovery of international peace and hope to realize our contribution to world peace by promoting the Budo Karate, against any kind of war.

Let's join our forces and do our best!

### ③. Various Forms

Although we understand that some Branches/Countries have their own method, the forms helped us to do administrative work efficiently, and we appreciate your kind understanding.

### ④. Invitation of Japanese Instructors

The WKO office receives numerous invitations for Japanese instructors every year. Standard procedure calls for the Official Invitation Letter to be sent to the WKO Office with the necessary information filled in. The invitation becomes official only when the letter arrives at the WKO Office. Please refrain from direct negotiations with Japanese instructors, for it will only lead to problems in the future. Finally, we would like for all to understand that an agreement based on direct negotiations will not be considered an official invitation.

### ⑤. Acceptance of Students from Overseas Branches

Every year, numerous students from overseas branches visit Japan for training. When a student wishes to visit Japan for training, standard procedure calls for the Branch Chief or Contact (whom the student belongs to) to contact the WKO Office of the ideal time frame, dojo, and detailed information (name, dan/kyu, age, etc.) of the student. The WKO Office will confirm the content of the request with the Branch Chief/Contact of the dojo in Japan. In a case where an overseas student goes forth with his/her training in Japan without consulting the WKO Office, it would delay the response time of the WKO Office if an emergency happened to occur. To assure the safety of the students, we ask for everyone's cooperation in this matter.

### ⑥. Centralization of communication between Overseas Branches

It is required that communication (related to events within the organization) between Overseas Branches and Japanese Branch Chiefs and contacts be exchanged through the WKO Office.

### **Call of attention to athletes participating in international sporting events**

Thank you very much for your understanding and cooperation in the activities of the Japan Sports Fairness Organization (JSFO).

Recently, there have been reports that 23 Chinese swimmers have tested positive in the doping tests conducted before the Tokyo 2020 Olympic and Paralympic Games in 2021, and comments have been sent out from various organizations concerned.

The World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) released a fact sheet and FAQs on April 29, 2012, regarding this issue, and stated that this case is related to contamination of food and other substances ingested by the athletes.

Contamination of food and supplements is a very serious problem for clean athletes. The Organization has been developing the "Athlete Protection (currently suspended)," an application to record food and supplement intake, and providing information through video distribution, for Japanese athletes who will compete in the Olympic and Paralympic Games in Tokyo in 2021 and Beijing in 2022. The company has also developed an app called "Athlete Protection (currently unavailable)" to record dietary and supplement intake and provide information through video distribution. In anticipation of this year's Games to be held in Paris, we have reorganized the information that athletes should pay attention to as follows.

We would like to ask our member organizations to inform all athletes and entourage members who will participate in the International Games.

Athletes and entourage members are reminded of the following:

#### **1. Attention regarding eating and drinking**

- ✓ When you eat or drink, keep a record of what you have consumed (photos, food diary, receipts, etc.).
- ✓ If you eat or drink outside the athletes' village during the competition, go with more than one person and consume the same food as much as possible.
- ✓ When consuming beverages, choose unopened ones, avoiding those that have been opened or without lids.

#### **2. Attention regarding medications and supplements**

- ✓ Always consult a professional before taking any medication, whether over-the-counter or prescription.
- ✓ Apply for a TUE for prescription drugs, if necessary, and be aware of the validity period of any TUE granted.
- ✓ Record or keep records of prescriptions, packaging, lot numbers, etc. for the medicines you are taking, whether or not a TUE is granted, and also keep some of the medicines themselves if there are any leftovers.
- ✓ If you take supplements, record or keep the receipt of purchase, packaging, lot number, etc., and if possible, keep a portion of the product itself, along with the container.
